This book is designed to be a conceptual review for medical students during their preclinical years. It contains tremendous, high yield summaries in each chapter, followed by 201 board-relevant questions that challenge the student on many levels. All 12 chapters focus on concepts that are pivotal for passing board exams, and consist of high yield tables, flowcharts, and mnemonics. All questions are written with the goal of strengthening pathophysiologic relationships. They are written in a clinically-based, vignette-style in order to best simulate the questions seen on many course exams and the USMLE Step I exam. At the end of each section is an answer key with detailed explanations. Medical school involves innumerable hours of memorization, and therefore the goal of this book is to allow for more logical comprehension rather than brute memorization.
