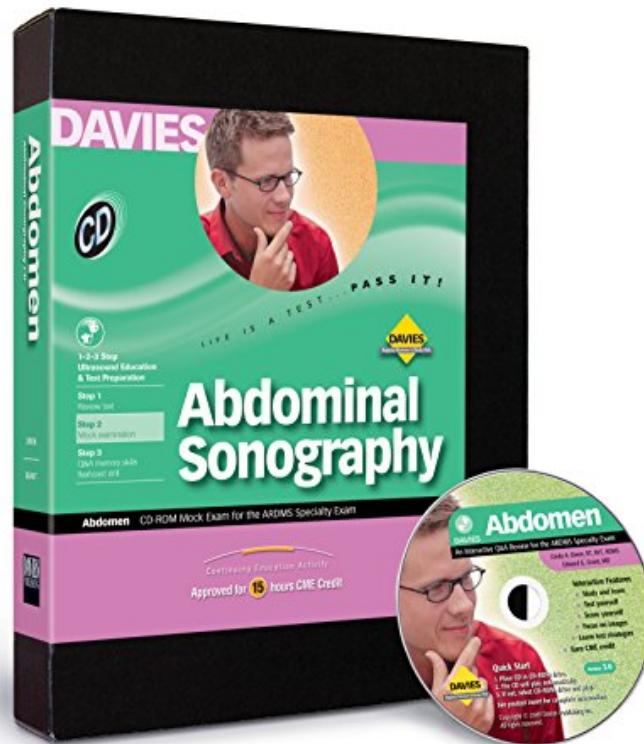

I took the exam a few days ago and passed- but I would not have passed if I relied on this book as my primary study guide. I also used Edelman workbook for abdomen (bought it used), Sanders and Dolk blue review book, and online study tool (ultrasound registry review- very comprehensive but helpful if you did not take exam right out of school like me). I also reviewed some sections of class textbooks to clarify things that were a bit sketchy. It took me about 6 weeks to study (last three weeks were very intense sessions and LONG days mostly spent studying). To check my progress I used Edelman X-Zone, and my test score was consistent with my ARDMS passing score so Edelman's questions were similar level of ARDMS difficulty for me. I am so thankful I passed with a decent score and on the first try. Good luck to anyone studying, you will need to review and study well, but it is certainly "doable". I was also surprised at small parts questions-- I did not expect to see quite so many (but perhaps just my take), but thankfully I used the ARDMS blueprint for the exam and I did study with this reference. There were enough of these small parts questions (not too many) but enough to make a difference

between pass and fail if you only focused on the basics like liver, pancreas, biliary, urinary. Also don't forget basic physics to improve image quality/transducers and also anatomy (peritoneum, retroperitoneum). Good luck! 0 of 0 people found the following review helpful. I was RDMS registered in only Breast and just sat for my Abdomen boards and passed on the first try. This was the only study material that I used for the Abdomen exam because I do better with studying that's more interactive and questioning like an exam rather than trying to concentrate on words in a textbook. I actually scored the best on this exam out of the Physics and Breast exams that I've also taken--and I used the Davies CD's as study prep for the other 2 exams as well (BOTH also passed on the first try). I really liked how I could design my own tests so I would study all questions in a section at a time until I went through them all. The only thing I felt it was lacking was more patient-care style of questions--yes, it's a small percentage on the ARDMS exam but it could be that "make it or break it" factor for some test takers and I felt that this material just wasn't adequate preparation for that portion of the exam. 0 of 0 people found the following review helpful.
