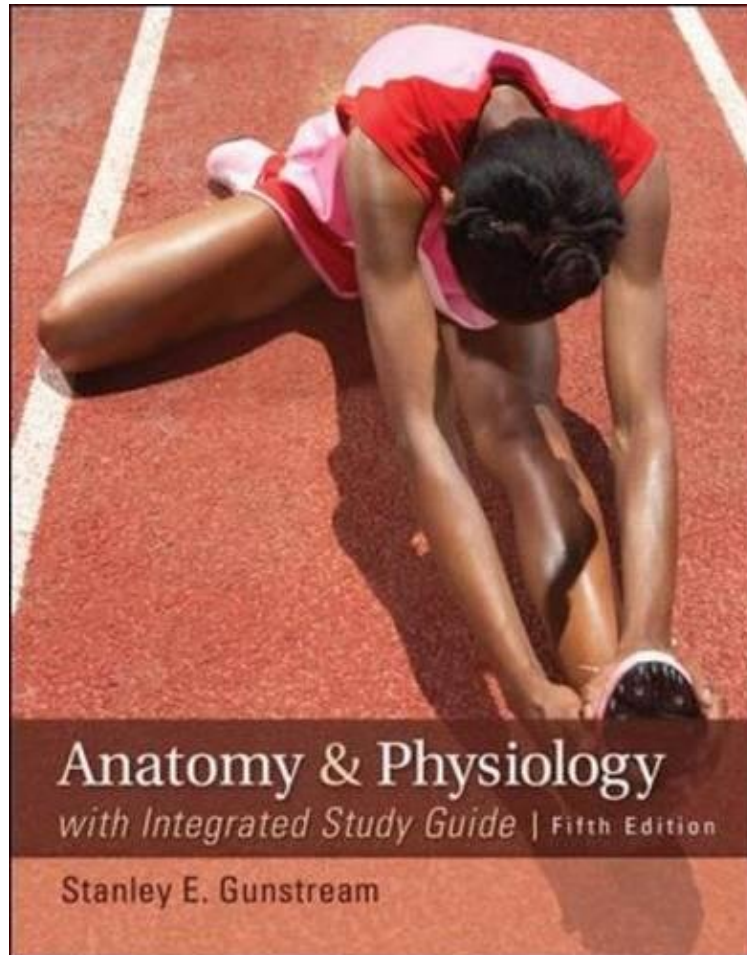

In 6 months of AP classes, we have NEVER used this book as it is so poorly written and disorganized that it's easier to use Google, Wikipedia, or even YouTube videos to learn and understand the material.The sad part is, this was one of the most expensive books I had to buy at close to \$100 and it has turned out to be a complete waste. Since we're required to bring it to class anyway, it has unfortunately gotten a little scratched and dinged up so I'll be lucky to get \$40 for it, hopefully from a student in the next class. My Med-Surg textbook (fairly similar) is twice as

comprehensive, over 1,000 pages, very well written, extremely useful (I use it everyday, even for this AP class) and it cost me less than half the price I paid for this book. As is the case with most McGraw Hill books I have to purchase, they are always overpriced and poorly written.
