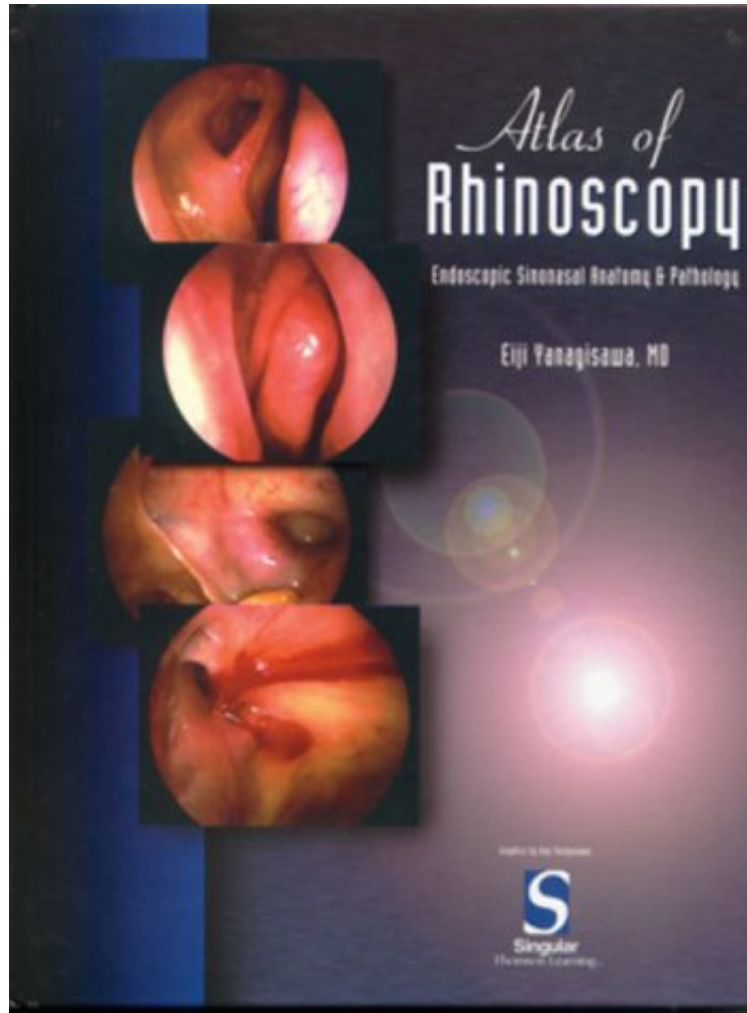

The use of abbreviations is somewhat annoying and some of figures have complicated labelling and the laterality switches for some photos within a single group, which is sometimes confusing. It would have been nice to have more correlations with CT scans.
