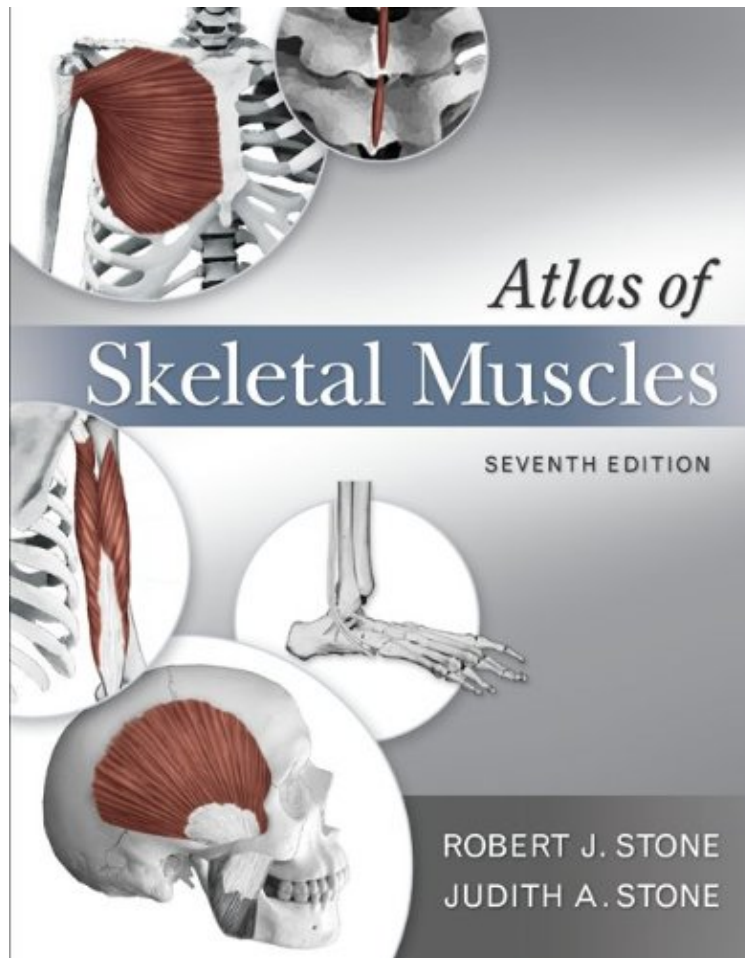

Have just about worn it out. In the original, drawings are big, black and white, line drawings, with strong contrast, almost a woodcut type of feel. Clear concise notes. I don't like the new version at all. Tried to glitz it up, and missed the mark. On the vertebral drawings, the image takes up only 1/3 of the page, with notes below. The lower third is blank. Contrast is very flat, looks much better on the kindle version sample I saw. The muscle drawings are worse yet. Computer drawings, look like colorforms toys from my childhood. Doesn't look like a muscle, striations are nearly absent. Again, flat contrast, weak color. Images on the front cover look much better than in the text. Maybe I can find a copy of the old version, with good illustrations. Glad I didn't spring for a new copy. Hate the plastic comb, that is why the pages tore out in my old
