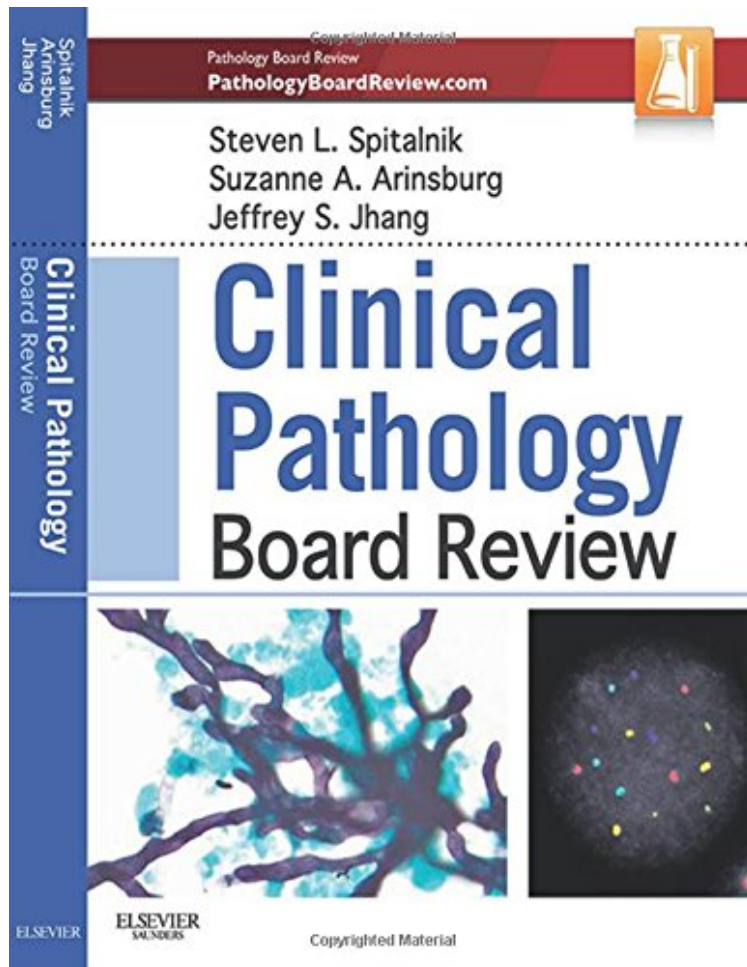

Blood bank questions are relatively few but too many detailed questions of apheresis and HPC!! Molecular is either too easy or has too many questions focusing on rare entities like mitochondrial diseases. Overall putting too many questions focusing in details on rare aspect in different specialties in clinical pathology will not fit the main path
