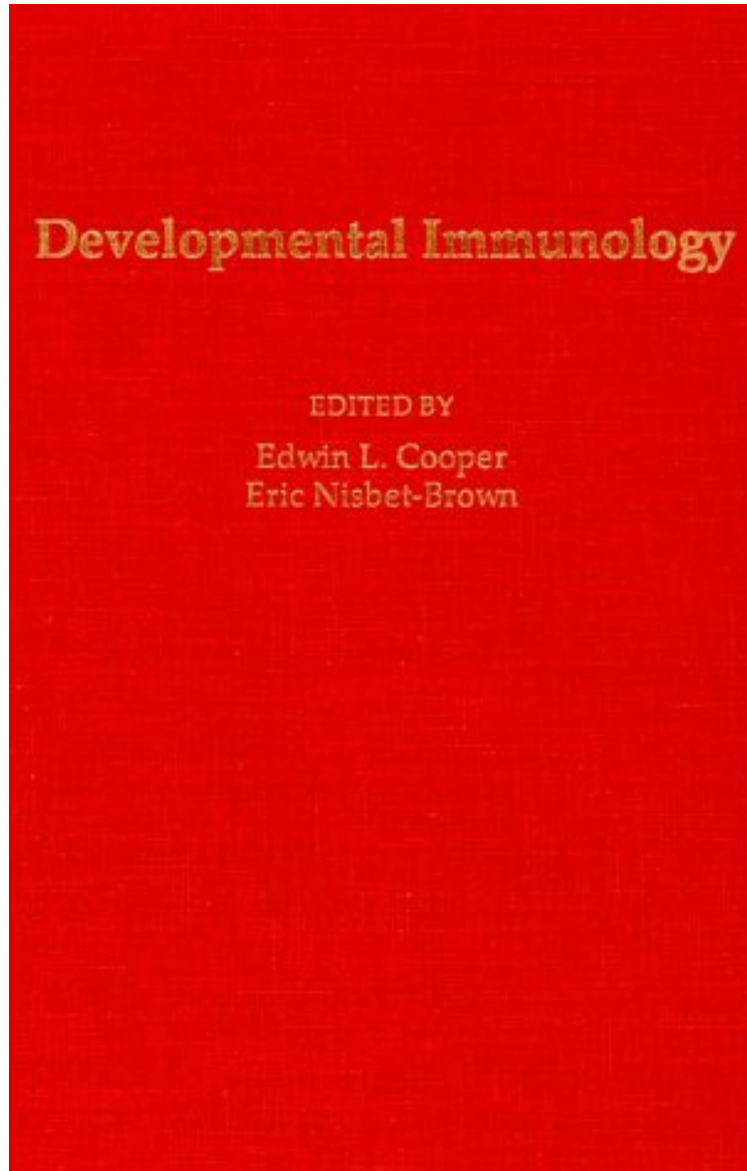

Throughout the book, an effort has been made to compare and integrate information from studies in diverse systems, and to discuss the limitations of such comparisons. This work will be of special interest to immunologists and theoretical, cell and developmental biologists, and much of the book will be useful to physicians working in pediatrics, internal medicine and reproductive medicine.
