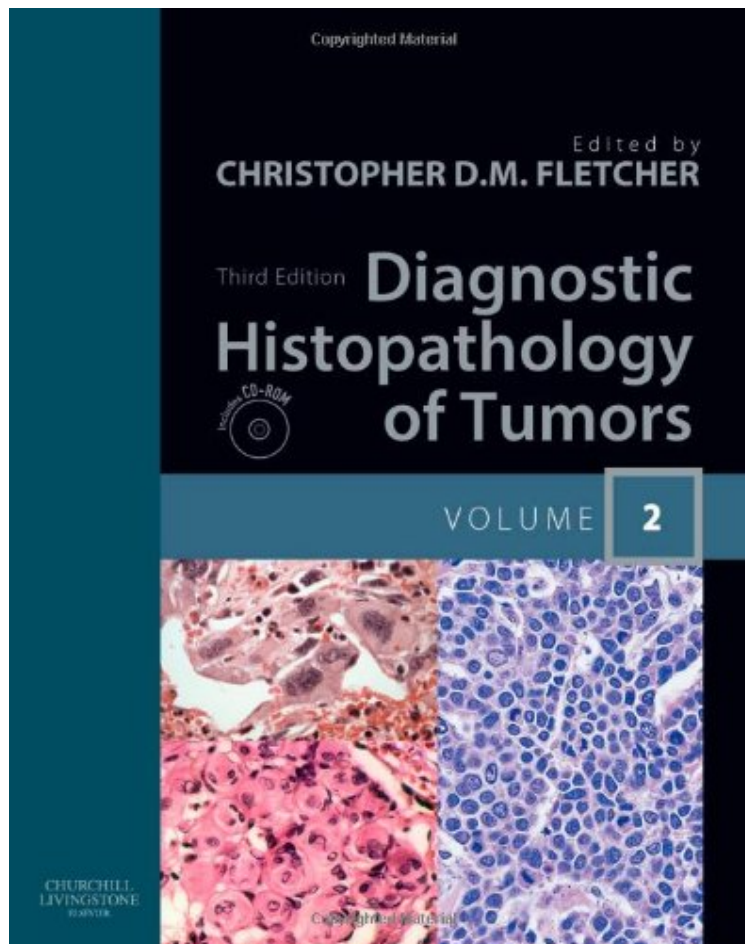

This is a great supplement to standard surgical pathology texts and presents the essential and esoteric diagnostic information in a concise formatted discussion using clinical information, gross and microscopic pathologic findings as well as various immunohistochemical and molecular markers for the various tumor entities.
