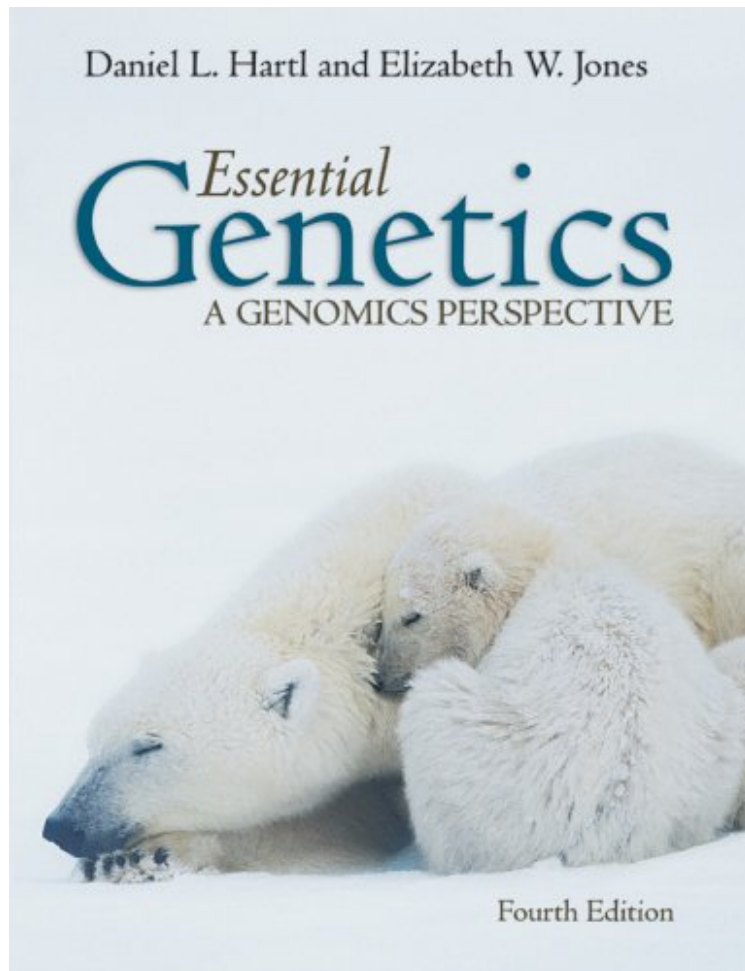

The meanings of many vocab words were not apparent through context, and there were numerous errors in the problems and answer key. The thousands of attention-grabbing real-life situations and hooks about genetics that could have been used to open up sections and chapters weren't used. Rather, the text is dense, boring, and unclear.
