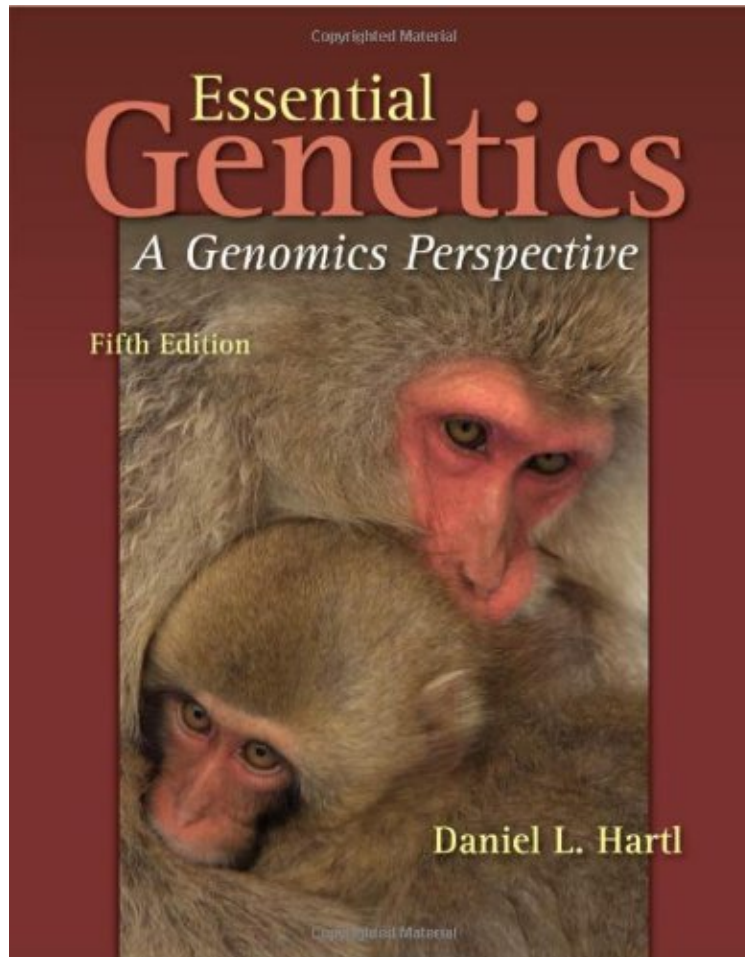

misspelling of "Archaea". In a textbook, there definitely shouldn't be mistakes in the spelling of words related to the subject matter. In addition, I've seen mistakes in the concept problems at the end of some of the chapters. I found most of the diagrams to be clear, but my professor often supplemented them by bringing in examples from other books that he claimed were better. Sometimes diagrams referenced in the text would be on the following page, so I would be flipping pages back and forth to look at the diagrams and the text. The biggest upside to this book was the price. I paid just over \$50 to buy it new and it came with access to online resources. At the time I am writing this review, the price for a new copy is more than \$110. I would not recommend buying this if it isn't required for a class.
